The rest of the after-school provision will remain the same.

You can now use your HMRC account to pay After School fees, or Nursery fees, through Tax Free Childcare. You are not allowed to pay for lunches. If you have used it before we joined Pele Trust, you will need to delete the school and search again, our new Unique Reference Number is 151716

Everything you owe currently should appear on your accounts. Please can these be paid in full by the end of the term.

The easiest way to handle payments is to download the IRIS Parentmail App to your phone and log in to your account. Click on the 3 lines on the left hand side at the top, scroll to payments and you should be able to see your payments detailed. You cannot offset previous lunch credit against After School clubs or Nursery fees.

Your lunch money appears in real time at the end of each week and is linked to the register. You can pay this each week, up front, or through ApplePay or Paypal. This gives you many more options. We can see that most of you are successfully using this payment option. A handful of parents haven't accessed the new system. Please could you do so as quickly as possible so that we can check your account is working correctly.

The new uniform provider is up and running.
Uniform can be ordered and delivered free to school and there is a small amount of stock at MA Tayloring in Bow Alley, Alnwick, where you can check the sizing.
